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# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

his EMIS report 2022 A.D. (2079/2080) is the 1<sup>st</sup> edition of Makawanpur Multiple Campus. It presents the information, data and status of 2022 A.D. of Makawanpur Multiple Campus, Hetauda.

#### **Physical Status**

The campus has 2 ropani land, 7 buildings, 57 classrooms, 2 botanical gardens, 1 seminar hall and auditorium hall, 18 toilets, 8 laboratory & 4 Sports facilities. There are 1008 desk and benches, 149 computers, 37 printers, 75 multimedia projectors and 2 websites. Total 512 science equipments are available in the campus. The campus has 3 library rooms with 86298 books. Total 3777 visited campus library in 2022 A.D. The campus has 5 vehicles.

#### **Enrollment**

In 2022 A.D., the total enrollment in different programs and levels in this campus is 3917. Among them, 1726 are male and 2191 are female students.

#### Result

646 passed out of 2577 in Bachelor's Degree programs in Annual system. 244 passed out of 299 students in Bachelor's Degree on Semester system and 110 students passed out of 268 students in Master's programs.

#### Graduated

Total 321 students are graduated in 2021 AD which include 101 male and 220 females.

#### **Human Resource**

There are total 83 teaching faculties, 30 non-teaching staffs and 2 internees in 2021 A.D. There 2 security guards and 2 office helpers are working through outsourcing.

#### Research

The total number of faculty member who are conducting mini-research in 2022 A.D. is 2. Total 52 Faculty members published research articles. The total number of faculties members participate in different programs outside the campus is 25. The campus conducted 15 different workshops, trainings, seminars and programs. The numbers of total participants in these programs are 629.

#### **Scholarship**

The total amount of scholarship provided by campus internal sources in 2021 A.D. and 2022 A.D. are Rs. 20,36250.00. Total 250 students are benefitted from the scholarship. 25 students get full scholarship through Tribhuvan University, Faculty of Management, Special Program (Self Sustain Program) Scholarship which is also by campus internal resources. Total 134 students get different kind of scholarship outside the campus like Hetauda Sub-Metropolitan City, District Co-ordination Committee, Makawanpur, UGC and others.

Total 1374 students are participated different programs like sports, Tour, Field Trip, Social works, orientation programs etc.

Out of these 646 students are passed. 390 out of 1535 female students are passed. Total 141 out of 641 *EDJ* students are passed. 15 *Dalit* students out of 72 are passed.
